I am so thankful for you!!! Your prayers, support and generosity mean so much to us! We have definitely been encouraged by your phones calls, text messages, and emails during this time.

The Bridge Church officially launched March 1st and it was amazing... There were 227 people in attendance. The Gospel was presented, people worshipped, people committed and recommitted their life to Christ.

Two weeks after our Grand Opening we had to close the church building down! We were heartbroken and really didn't understand but we continued to trust in the Lord. Well, during our preview services God provided us a videographer who was looking for a church home. He's been recording our videos and placing them online and God hasn't left us or forsaken us.

In fact, we haven't lost any momentum and God has even been growing our church online... I walked in a local gas station here in Fredericksburg, and a lady came up to me and said, "I watched your Easter service and I want you to know, I was encouraged and will now be giving to your church."

Also the generosity of the church hasn't stopped. During this time we are continuing to be the hands and feet of Jesus. Our church wrote letters and provided gift cards to local hospitals, we've fed local businesses and the fire departments, and we've started partnering with a local food bank and started a food pantry for kids who are now missing out on the free lunches in our community. They happen every Monday and Wednesday.

Our family has been doing well. Although Lily is unable to go practice gymnastics or go to school she is still learning and doing cartwheels in the house. Megan has been working hard in the hospital and Chris has been getting to know the neighbors and bringing them doughnuts.
