WORSHIP MINISTRY

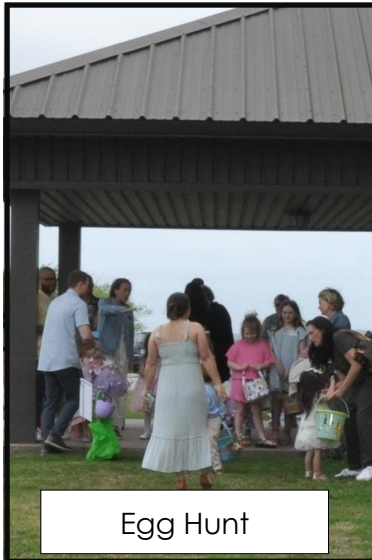
We have added new colored lights in our sanctuary!
